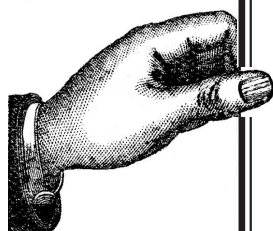

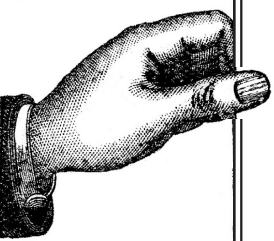

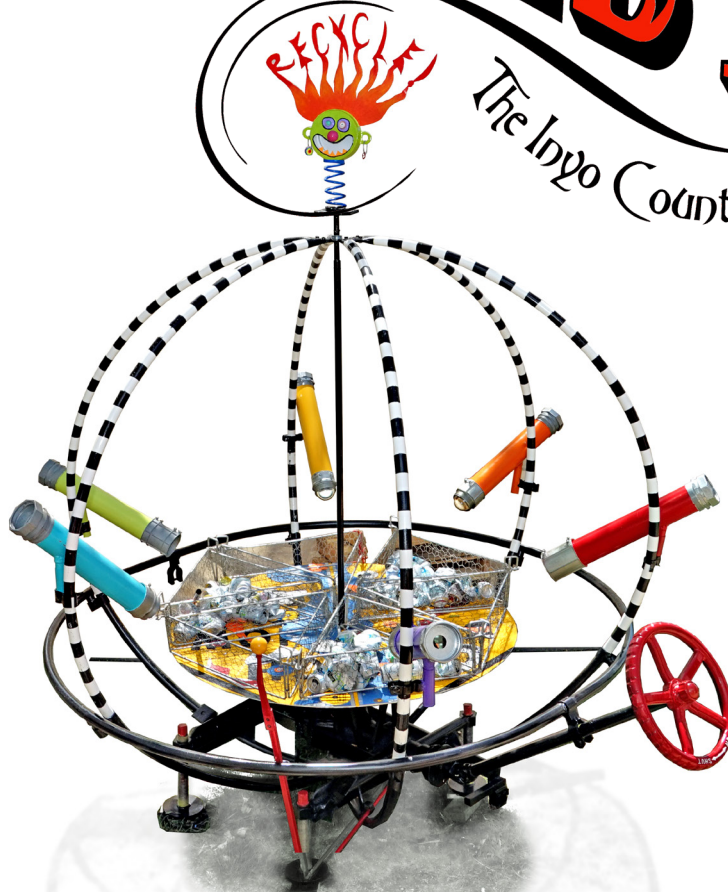

The Inyo County Recyclescope



She is a monster re-cyclescope. That means a kaleidoscope made out of found things. A kaleidoscope is a tube with mirrors in it that changes the way you see things.

Gladys has 6 different kaleidoscopes that you can look through – each one is different.

Inyo County Commissioned this kaleidoscope to show how much fun recycling can be. It was designed by Judyth Greenburgh – a kaleidoscope artist from Darwin and was made in collaboration with artists – David Tidewell from Bishop and Jael Hoffmann from Olancho.

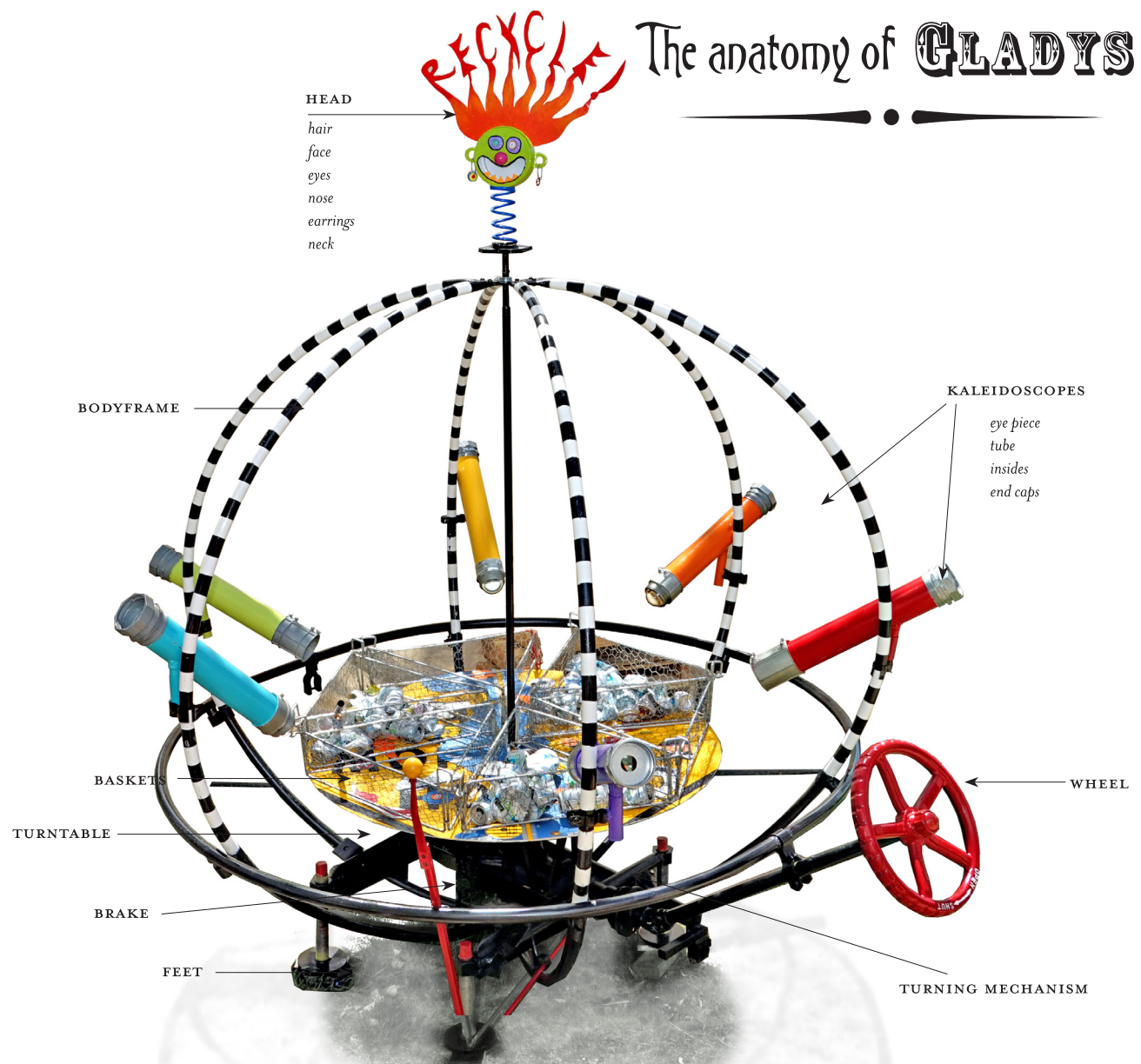

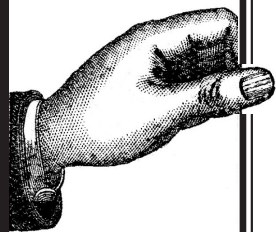

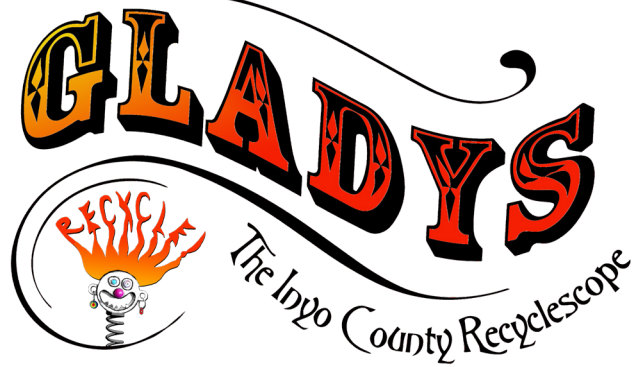
### OPEN / SHUT OFF WATER VALVE

Conduit, fittings, paint, duct tape,  
glue, epoxy, custom cutting & welding.



**HOW** to feed



**1. STOP!**

Wait for the signal that she has stopped spinning  
Make sure it's safe to approach Gladys.  
Pick up a used basket from her turntable belly.

**2. GET READY**

Refill her food at the **RECYCLE BUFFET**  
Use gloves if you wish - and remember to return them!  
Empty and sort the recycling into their relevant bins

Gather your own to make interesting colors and shapes  
Don't overfill the wedges ( just to the top please)  
Place your filled basket back into her turntable belly.

**3. GO!**

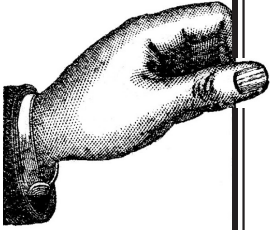
One of you turn the wheel to make her spin  
6 of you can look through the kaleidoscopes - each one is different.  
Give others a chance to view

**4. BE SAFE!**

Have an adult with you if under 10yrs of age  
No one is to touch Gladys while she is spinning  
Do not climb under the horizontal bar.  
There is a brake to stop the table rotating in an emergency.



# How do you feed her?



Gladys has a HUGE appetite and is always hungry.  
To keep her from eating YOU! Feed her what she loves.

At the recycle buffet you'll find 4 bins with her favorite recycled 'food'.
